



# Preventive Safety Measures

It is important that persons administering vaccines to farmed fish follow the recommended preventive safety measures to minimize the risk of accidental self-injection



## PROPER TRAINING

Proper training in vaccination techniques, first aid, and procedures to follow in case of accidental self-injection.

## USE SAFETY CLIP/ NEEDLE GUARD

Correct mounting and use of the safety clip/needle guard on the needle. The safety clip should be attached to the syringe to protect the fingers and hand from the needle tip.

## GLOVES FOR GRIP

Use of appropriate gloves to ensure a good grip on the fish.

## REGULAR BREAK

Take regular breaks, maintain a comfortable working posture, and ensure good lighting. Make sure the vaccination pace does not compromise quality or safety.

## PROPERLY ANESTHETIZED FISH

It is very important to ensure the fish is properly anesthetized. Many accidental self-injections occur when fish are struggling.

## NOTIFY THE LOCAL DOCTOR IN ADVANCE

Notify the local doctor in advance about when vaccination will begin and bring "To the Doctor" leaflet
